

FestiVELO App



The FestiVelo app puts everything you need to know right at your fingertips. From driving directions and location within Walterboro, to route descriptions, maps, and even weather, you have everything you need to make your ride easy, safe, and fun.

Indeed, should you call for help, the first question you'll be asked is, "Have you installed the app?" That's because the app lets you send your location to the director so support can be sent straight to you, with notification of the driver's location, speed, and time of arrival (kind of like Uber).

Scan the QR code to install, or search for "FestiVelo" on the App Store or Google Play.

For iPhone, just point your camera at the QR code to read.

FestiVelo RideWithGPS Club Account

FestiVelo has a RideWithGPS event account, which gives you free access to advanced features of the RideWithGPS web site and smartphone app. To utilize these features, follow these steps:

RideWithGPS web site

1. Open [RideWithGPS.com](https://www.RideWithGPS.com) and register as a user (choose a Starter account, which is free).
2. Authorize yourself to the FestiVelo club account by scanning the QR code, below, or opening this link: <https://bit.ly/39zjWnM>. You'll be prompted to sign-in to RideWithGPS with your email address and password (created in the above step).
3. After signing in you should see the FestiVelo logo on the left-hand side of the Home page. Click the FestiVelo logo and you will be in the FestiVelo club section.
4. Click 'Events' to see the list of FestiVelo routes for each day.
5. Click 'Collections' to see all of the routes in one place.

6. Install the RideWithGPS app from your respective app store. (If you already have the app installed, you may need to re-install it if you can't access the club features.)
7. Log into RideWithGPS from the app. On the app's home screen, tap the **More** icon on the bottom-right, then tap **Organizations**, and then **FestiVelo**.
8. From the resulting FestiVelo screen you have access to the **Events**, **Routes**, and **Collections**.
9. When a route is open, you can use the buttons at the bottom of the screen to **Navigate** (get turn-by-turn directions) or **Download** (use with no cellular signal). The **Location** icon on the map will display your current location.

Note: you can also join the RideWithGPS event account and access the RideWithGPS routes directly via the FestiVelo app!

Important! Be aware that GPS data in this area of the SC Lowcountry is poorly matched, so that Garmin or similar devices may become confused, particularly with turn-by-turn directions and where segments overlap, such as at rest stops. If you are unsure whether you're on course, stop and reference the route and your location via the FestiVelo app.





As a participant in Festivalo, you are supporting safer bicycling and walking in South Carolina, by supporting the work of the Palmetto Cycling Coalition. By registering and riding in Festivalo, you are in a unique position to advance this important cause by ensuring the sustainability of this important mission and work.

What does PCC do?

The Palmetto Cycling Coalition (PCC) is the statewide bike and walk advocacy organization for South Carolina. Since 1995, the PCC advocated at the state and local levels for safety, through advancing better access and education, to promote healthy lifestyles and livable and economically viable communities. PCC focuses on partnerships, because safe streets are for everyone. The work of the PCC centers on state advocacy with a legislative agenda and agency advisement, and also empowers local movements and provides educational resources.

A Few of PCC's Many Accomplishments:

1. Founded the SC Livable Communities Alliance, and successfully achieved a state Complete Streets policy with SCDOT.
2. Provided support to start many local movements, empower local advocates and engagement, grow new coalitions, partnerships and advocacy skills, and ultimately aided in new local policies and funding.
3. Achieved passage of Act No. 114, H.3714, the Electric Bicycle bill of 2020.
4. Achieved passage of Act No. 317, H.3006, the Bicycle bill of 2008.
5. Advanced through the state legislature: H.3355, S.723, the Distracted Driving bills, H.3656, the Complete Streets bill, H.3172, the Pedestrian Signal bill, and H.3173, the Vulnerable Road User bill.
6. Hosted two statewide and two regional Bike & Walk Summits (2012, 2017(2), 2018)
7. Launched Safe Streets Save Lives, SC's first strategic educational campaign to reduce bicycling fatalities, training 90+ ambassadors, since 2011.
8. Represented South Carolina on Capitol Hill during the National Bike Summit for fifteen consecutive years (2005-2019)
9. Since 2005, hosted nine Complete Streets workshops throughout South Carolina. Partnered with Eat Smart Move More SC to print, publish, and distribute Complete Streets Toolkit and Advocacy Manual.
10. Wrote and advocated for the bicycle traffic safety law update in SC Drivers Manual in 2006, 2008, and 2011.
11. Assisted and facilitated six municipalities statewide in receiving the Bicycle Friendly Community status, from 2007 to 2012.
12. Distributed over 25,000 SC bicycle law cards and items to various entities since 2008.



Festival Routes

A Reference Guide to the Festivelo Routes

The next pages are organized for you to be able to tear out and take on your ride of choice. They are organized by day. Each sheet will give you turn by turn directions through Walterboro and Colleton County. If you prefer a digital version please download our Festivelo app.

FestiVelo Cue Sheet Cues

This is YOUR FestiVelo! There are 3, or more, marked routes with start times listed for each day, every day. You can ride a different route, going in a different direction. Most rides start from Colleton County Museum, 506 E Washington St, Walterboro, SC 29488 at 0800. We use a side street, NEYLE St. as the start/finish. It's your choice when and where you ride. We asked that you stay on our marked routes (yes, you can ride them in reverse). Please honor our Rest Stop opening and closing times. You don't have to ride the routes in sequence. If you want to avoid traffic or mass starts, use the driving instructions, drive to lunch stop and pick the loop(s) you want to ride paying attention to the Rest Stop times.

This is YOUR FestiVelo!

Short route is YELLOW - 30 mi.
Medium is YELLOW/RED - 60 mi.
Long varies - 100 mi.

1. The color scheme for all the routes of FestiVelo is:
 - Yellow out and back*
 - Red loop 1*
 - White loop 2*
 - Blue loop 3*
2. Right and left are FULL turns. Bear is a leaning almost straight route.
3. Stop means Stop. There are hazard out there, you should take appropriate measures.
4. Turns are listed as Road name/route #: Hydrick Rd/S-15-272. On top of every intersection W marker is a small, 3 X 12, black and white sign. /S-15-272 is the South Carolina road designation located on top of the road sign marker. SC-S-X-Y: SC South Carolina, S secondary, X- County the route is in, Y- county maintenance #. People steal road signs; No one steals the little black signs.
5. Turns are marked with a white circle and a colored "Tail", like 0-. The O is white, the tail (-) will match the route color. Riders have marked the course as they would wanted the course marked.
6. Before every turn, we marked approx. 100yds prior a Mark indicating direction, 100ft we mark again, at the intersection we mark again. The first marker will be beside any "intersection-ahead" sign, or at a comparable distance, ~100 yards, if there is no sign. After you make a turn you will find another mark confirming the turn. If you don't see a mark after a turn, you're off course.
7. Every 3 miles, on long legs, is a mark.W
8. After every intersection Diamond sign along your route, is a route mark.
9. If you don't want to get lost, download our app and use it! Put the cue sheet in your hotel room and leave it there.
10. To save space the word "TURN" has been omitted.
11. We will not leave you out on the course. We have SAG trucks and Motorcycles. If you need assistance, just tap your helmet. We'll stop. Even better use our app, it provides SAG with your exact location.

GREEN ROUTE REPRESENTS ROAD SECTIONS MARKED IN WHITE








